

Guidelines for safe management of visits and outings (3 December 2021)

To be read in conjunction with the COVID 19 - visitor policy (3 December 2021)

These guidelines are in line with the MOH COVID- 19 Protection Framework which is unpinned by the vaccination rates in the region / DHB and the positive COVID community cases

<u>Unvaccinated</u>	Vaccinated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visits are allowed with a negative COVID-19 surveillance test just prior to visiting (antigen test) • Visits will be managed within set timeframes • All visitors and the resident must wear a mask (or full PPE) as requested by the Facility Manager. • Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No social outings permitted
Vaccinated	<u>Unvaccinated</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No visiting is permitted • Should a visit be allowed on compassionate grounds in the event of end of life/palliative care, it will be managed by the Facility Manager <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The visitor must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within the last 48 hours – All visitors must wear full PPE which will be at their own cost. – Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No social outings permitted

Vaccinated	Vaccinated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visits are allowed in a managed process within the set visiting timeframes. • The number of visitors and the length of the visit may be determined by the Facility Manager • Visits will be allowed outside of the visiting timeframes on compassionate grounds in the event of end of life/palliative care in discussion with the Facility Manager • All visitors must wear a mask or (full PPE) as defined by the Facility Manager. • Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radius encourages visits to be in a controlled environment such as in the facility or home of <u>vaccinated</u> family/friends or in an outdoor setting • Radius strongly discourages social outings into the wider public. • Masks required • Social distancing • Whanau/Friend to maintain safety precautions using QR codes
<u>Unvaccinated</u>	Vaccinated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visits are allowed in a managed process within the set visiting timeframes. • The number of visitors and the length of the visit may be determined by the Facility Manager • Visits will be allowed outside of the visiting timeframes on compassionate grounds in the event of end of life/palliative care in discussion with the Facility Manager • All visitors and the resident must wear a mask or (full PPE) as defined by the Facility Manager. • Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radius encourages visits to be in a controlled environment such as in the facility or home of <u>vaccinated</u> family/friends or outdoor setting • Radius does not support an outings into the wider public due to vaccination status • Masks required • Social distancing • Whanau/Friend to maintain safety precautions using QR codes

Vaccinated	Vaccinated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unrestricted visiting within the allocated visiting times as indicated by each facility • Masks required • Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residents are free to go out on outings • Radius encourages visits to be in a controlled environment such as in the facility or home of vaccinated family/friends or outdoor settings • Masks required • Social distancing • Whanau/Friend to maintain safety precautions using QR codes
<u>Unvaccinated</u>	Vaccinated	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unrestricted visiting within the allocated visiting times as indicated by each facility • All visitors and the resident must wear a mask • Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radius encourages visits to be in a controlled environment such as in the facility or home of <u>vaccinated</u> family/friends or outdoor settings • Radius does not support outings to the wider public (e.g. shops supermarket malls etc.) due to vaccination status • Masks required • Social distancing • Whanau/Friend to maintain safety precautions using QR code

Vaccinated	<u>Unvaccinated</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No visiting is permitted. • Should a visit be allowed on compassionate grounds in the event of end of life/palliative care, it will be managed by the Facility Manager <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The visitor must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within the last 48 hours – All visitors must wear full PPE which will be at their own cost. – Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radius does not support outings with an unvaccinated person • Should an outing take place, Radius strongly encourages visits to be in a controlled environment such as in the facility or home of <u>vaccinated</u> family/friends or outdoor settings • Masks required • Social distancing • Whanau/Friend to maintain safety precautions using QR codes
<u>Unvaccinated</u>	<u>Unvaccinated</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No visiting is permitted. • Should a visit be allowed on compassionate grounds in the event of end of life/palliative care, it will be managed by the Facility Manager <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – The visitor must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within the last 48 hours – All visitors must wear full PPE which will be at their own cost. – Minimum social distancing of one metre 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radius does not support outings
